We are thankful to be able to come alongside and help these faithful pastors and their congregations. The church in Río Fonseca will get a concrete floor. The church in Trinchera has already begun replacing their building that was literally falling apart. Several more churches will be able to benefit from these funds as well.

Multiple organizations have recently donated items that we have been giving out; <u>Shoes that Grow, reading glasses</u>, and <u>BEAMS Bibles</u>. Also, a group sent funds to purchase <u>1500 Bibles for a public school outreach</u> planned to take place in September during "Month of the Bible".
